Domestic violence towards the sons and its impact on psychological loneliness feelings (A Field study applied on a sample of First- Secondary Grade in Damascus Country side (The first class))

Abstract

This study aims to investigate the relationship between the domestic violence towards the sons and the psychological loneliness feelings. The sample of the study was 100 students - 50 male & 50 female, and two questionnaires were used: - Paternity offense act questionnaire. - the psychological loneliness feelings questionnaire.

To verify the hypotheses the researcher used analytic method and some necessary statistical rules such as:

- T -Test -Person correlation -Standard deviations -One-way analysis of variance -Scheffe test -Means -SPSS Program.

The findings of this research were as follows:

- There is a statistical significant relationship between the domestic violence towards the sons and the psychological loneliness feelings.
- There are statistical significant differences between means of the domestic violence towards the sons with regard to (Gender, Father education level, Mother education level).
- There are statistical significant differences between means of the psychological loneliness feelings with regard to (Gender, Father education level, Mother education level).
