The perspectives of post graduate students in the educational colleges at Mu'tah and Yarmouk Universities of the problems that face them

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Abstract

This study aimed at investigating the perspectives of post graduate students in the educational colleges at Mu'tah and Yarmouk Universities regarding the problems that face them. The sample of the study consisted of (324) students during the first semester of the academic year 2006|2007.

A questionnaire consisted of (53) items was distributed at three domains: problems related to students, staff member, and university administration, in order to achieve the study goals.

The finding of the study revealed a moderate estimation for the perspectives. The main problems were: the high cost of study, the low level of English, and the indifferences in perspectives of graduate students due to the study variables: University, Gender, and study level.

The study recommended the necessity to increase the financial support for the students.
