

The Relationship between Loneliness and Five factors of Personality

Abstract

This research aims at revealing the relationship between the Loneliness Scal (UCLA) and Five factors of personality Inventory (NEO-FFI-S) to the sample of students of the four faculties in Damascus university (the faculty of Education , Fine arts , Economics , and faculty of Informatics engineering) and the number of the students of the sample were 120 students .

This research aims to know the differences among the sample of the research in the (UCLA) and the (NEO-FFI-S) which has been attributed to the variable of the gender and the faculty.

After the test of hypotheses and its sub-hypotheses, we reached to the following finding

- 1- There is a positive significant correlation between the Loneliness (L) and Neuroticism (N).
- 2- There is a negative significant correlation between the (I) and Extroversion (E), Openness (O), Agreeableness (A), Conscientiousness (C).

- 3 – There is no significant difference in (L) and (N, E, O, A, C) that refers to the gender.
- 4 – There is no significant difference in (L) and (N, O, C) that refers to the faculty.
- 5-There is a significant difference in the (E) that refers to the faculty.
- 6 – There is a significant difference in (A) that refers to the faculty.
