The Negative Results of Natural Population Growth increase in the City of Daraa Between 1981 - 2010

Abstract

This research examines the negative results of population growth increase in Daraa city through using a lot of quantifications and demographic indicators to describe causes and effects of population average increase, such as increase in birth rate, or decrease in mortality rate.
