The Stoic Impact in Fakher AL Deen AL Razee''s Logic

Abstract

The Summary seeks through its title to show the impact of stoicism in Fakher Al_ Deen Al_Razee's logic. is it a direct impact through his reading to stoic source directly or through a mediator? We will attempt to find out that impact by reading the logical text of ALRazee's, once by reading his original books and another by comparing it to another text, which is his explanation of Avicenna's text in order to discover the logical impact and to clarify the main role of Avicenna's in making impact.

It is important to point out that the research will follow the attitude of the 'explainer' manifested in his explanations to see if he accepts them, or just plays the role of explaining them.
