Youth and the Population Issue in Syria

Abstract

This research is an analytical study of a general opinion that has been dominating for decades up till now . This opinion represents the point of view that the population growth in the third world-including Syria- is the main stumbling block on the way of development , and that crises and problems these countries face in economy, work, income, health and education ... etc are results of the increasing population.

Thus, success in achieving developmental challenges and economic results depends on the capacity of facing the population problem. This requires reduplicating efforts to advertise the ways of the modern application of birth control and family Planning. Moreover, unawareness among people –including the youth- of the dangers of high birth control, having no perception of their children's future in addition to ignorance of ways of family planning cause the problem to continue.
