## Pictures Patterns & Psychological Denotations In the Modern Poetry in Yemen

## Abstract

This paper discusses the poetic patterns and psychological which are conveyed by imagery in modern Poetry Divan in Yemen, and which Poets used to direct their meaning.

Images in poets divans varied between simile, sensational images and metaphorical prosopopoeia, embodiment, "symbolism" the images that displays poet mentality.

The psychological functions achieved by rhetorical uses create a bridge of understanding with audience.
