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# Words in Phrases: Words after Prepositions

After most prepositions, there is a noun or gerund (a noun with -ing).

**Examples:** The lexical approach is a good method of education. (noun after of)

The content-based approach is a good method of learning English. (gerund after of)

Exception: Usually, after the preposition to, there is the simple form of the verb.

Example: I need to solve this problem.

To comes after these verbs: need, want, hope, have (= must)
